

## Unpacking files with Stuffit

Due to size problems some of the files included in the Lund Simula system had to be compressed to make the system fit onto one diskette. The program to restore the files, "UnStuffIt" is included on the disk as well. It is fairly easy to use, but here is a step by step instruction for those who have not used it before.

There are two files that need un-stuffing:

Simula 4.07 reference.sit containing the Hypercard reference stack: Simula 4.07 reference  
and  
Sinterfaces.sit containing the toolbox interfaces files in a folder "Sinterfaces"

- Start UnStuffIt by double-clicking the icon.
- Choose "open archive" in the File menu
- Use the file-browser to select "Simula 4.07 reference.sit" and hit "open"
- The name appears in the UnStuffit window, clicking it again to select it
- Click the "Extract" Icon at the bottom of the Window
- Select an appropriate directory to put the Reference stack, MPW itself is good place. Please note that no directory should be selected when you hit the "save" button. There is no need to change the name of the restored file.
- The file is now restored in the chosen directory.
- UnStuffIt can be terminated by choosing "Quit" in the file-menu.

To also restore the toolbox interface repeat the operations above with the following exceptions:

- Create a folder Simula in MPW if not done already
- Open "Sinterfaces.sit"
- Choose MPW:Simula before hitting the "save" button.
