### **What is AniPlayer?**

AniPlayer is a program for the simultaneous playing of both Autodesk Animator®, Autodesk Animator Pro® and Autodesk 3d Studio® FLI and FLC Files along with Standard Midi sound files or WAV Sample files. The program is written in Microsoft® Visual Basic and will run under Microsoft® Windows Version 3.1

### **Windows Drivers**

The program has been tested and found to work with the following MCI Sound Drivers

Creative Labs® Sound Blaster  
Creative Labs® Sound Blaster Pro (OPL2 and OPL3 versions)  
Orchid® Sound Producer

The program has also been tested with the MSCDEX driver and will see all drives available to windows. i.e Hard Disks, Floppy Disks, CD Rom, Ram Drive etc.

The Program should work with any MCI Compatible sound device. Please advise of any Sound cards with which you have trouble.

### **Future versions**

Future versions will include the following:

A fully featured script editor for the editing of FLI and FLC files with sound to produce full Multimedia Presentations.

A professional Studio countdown clock and SMPTE Standard timecoding

Support for MCI CD Audio.

### **Installation**

To install AniPlayer, follow these steps:

Before you can use AniPlayer you have to run the setup program from Windows so it will work properly on your computer. You cannot just copy the files from the AniPlayer disk to your hard disk. The files on the distribution disk need to go into various subdirectories within Windows. The setup program places these files in the right subdirectories your working disk.

1. Make Windows' "Program Manager" the active window.
2. From Windows' "Program Manager", select "File", then select "Run". This will open the "Run" dialog box.
3. Place the copy of AniPlayer in your floppy drive. Now, the dialog box needs for you to type in the command that will run the AniPlayer installation program.

If your floppy disk goes in your Drive "A", type:

A:SETUP

If your floppy disk goes in your Drive "B", type:

B:SETUP

4. Fill in the required information in the dialog box.

It will ask you for the "Source Drive and Directory" designation where your AniPlayer floppy disk is located. (This is the same floppy drive designation you typed in the previous step before the word "setup".)

It will ask you for the hard disk "Destination Drive and Directory designation on which you want it to install AniPlayer. It will suggest a directory named "C:\AP".

If you want the AniPlayer program files installed on a different drive or directory, just click the pointer to the right of the characters you want to change, backspace over the ones you want to erase, then type in the new designation.

5. AniPlayer Setup will copy all the necessary files and place them into the correct subdirectories.
6. AniPlayer Setup will notify you when the installation is completed. It will automatically build a "Program Group" called Parsec AV Applications and add AniPlayer V1.0 to it .

AniPlayer is installed and ready to use. Double click the pointer on, the AniPlayer icon and away you go!

### **About the Shareware concept**
