SCHEDULE for Windows is a simple way of scheduling the execution of Windows and DOS related tasks. It allows you to setup the execution of certain programs at specified times of day either on a daily, weekly, monthly or annual basis. It will also let you open documents, bring up card files, etc. In other words, it honors the associations you have established for your Windows environment. All from a simple and easy to use window.

Installation

To install SCHEDULE for Windows, copy the executable file to your Windows directory (usually \WINDOWS). Then add SCHEDULE for Windows to your Startup group just as you would any other Windows program.

When you run SCHEDULE for Windows, it will create a .INI file (SCHEDULE.INI) in your Windows directory. This file is where your windows size and position, certain setup preferences and all schedule items are stored. Although this is a standard ASCII text file you should NOT edit the values that appear there. You may cause the loss of setup or scheduling information.

Shareware
