

SnapWin

SnapWin is a powerful tool for screen capture. It has some outstanding features that set it apart from existing screen capture utilities:

a. [Provides a timer mechanism.](#)

With the SnapWin timer set you can cleanly capture a real time screen. For example, you can "snap" the picture of a window with a pulldown menu. You can also "snap" the actual moment of an action on the screen such as pressing a button.

b. [Captures the cursor in a bitmap.](#)

You may want a captured picture to show a shaped cursor pointing at a given position. This action is done with SnapWin by simply selecting the cursor option.

c. [Provides a wide range of object selections.](#)

SnapWin can capture a window, the client area of a window, current active window, desktop, an owner drawn rectangular region or a fixed sized rectangle. Moreover, when you choose to capture a rectangular region, you can use the right button of the mouse to draw the desired area and capture the picture while the application is still available.

Snap Menu

Snap!

Save

Save the captured picture to a bitmap file. You can choose different file types, like RGB, RLE4, RLE8.

Copy

Copy the captured picture to Clipboard.

Print

Print the captured picture on a printer.

Exit

Exit the SnapWin system.

Zoom

Use this command to view the picture:

- 50%: Shrink to half its size.
- 100%: Display in normal size.
- 200%: Enlarge to twice its size.
- 400%: Enlarge to four times its normal size.

Full Screen

View the captured picture in full screen mode.

Bitmap Info

Show general information about the captured picture.

Clear Image

Erase the captured picture.

Window

Capture a complete window. Click the mouse on a window and the window picture is captured.

Client Area

Capture the client area of a window. Click the mouse on a window and the client area of the window is captured.

Rectangle

Capture a rectangular region of the screen. When you start capture, click the right mouse button and draw a rectangle. Since you are still free to use the left mouse button, this option will not block the normal process of an application.

Fixed Rectangle

Capture a fixed sized rectangular region of the screen when you know the exact size of the object (e.g. an icon, usually 32*32). When you start the capture, click the right mouse button and move the rectangle to the desired place.

Active Window

Capture the current active window. This option can be used together with the timer mechanism to "snap" the actual window.

Desktop

Capture the desktop picture. This option can be used together with the timer mechanism to "snap" the current desktop.

Capture Cursor

Capture the current cursor shape in the picture.

Enable Timer

Enable the timer mechanism.

Set Timer

Set the timer which measures in seconds.

Snap!

This command starts the snap process. First you have to specify the object you'd like to capture. (Note: When choosing Active Window or Desktop option, this step is not necessary since the object to be captured is clear.) With the timer enabled, the capture action starts after the preset number of seconds. If the timer is not enabled, the capture starts immediately.
