## What The Heck Is It?

Yet Another Clipboard Collector (YACC) is a Windows shareware utility that remembers the text that you copy or cut to the Windows Clipboard each time you copy or cut (up to **10000** characters). YACC stores the text in a list box in the upper half of its window. When you click on a selection in the list box, YACC displays the text in a more readable manner in the text box in the lower half of its window. YACC must be running for it to remember your text copies and cuts.

**Suggestions:** Add YACC to your Startup group and check the Run Minimized box to start and minimize YACC each time you start Windows. Please see Program Manager's Help for instructions on adding YACC to your Startup group.

When in other applications hit ALT + INSERT to quickly display YACC.

### **Why?**

If you cut and copy text often you probably get tired of going back to copy something that you've already copied before. This can be a real pain if it's a large selection that's located on the other side of a document, or even worse in a document that isn't open anymore.

If you've ever cut a selection of text that you realized you needed later, you'll like being able to retrieve that selection and pasting it back in.

### **Yet Another?**

No, this isn't a brand new idea. There are several other utilities that do the same thing, and even more, but I wanted a simple Clipboard history list without a lot of clutter. I got the idea from my brother, who is working on his own version (Thanks, Dan).

## Buttons and Commands

### **Click**

On a selection in the list box in the upper half of the YACC window to see the text more easily in the text box located in the lower half of the window.

### **Double-Click**

On a selection in the list box in the upper half of the YACC window to copy that text to the Windows Clipboard and return to the application that you were using before you switched to YACC. This is the same as the Copy button, but quicker.

### **Copy Button**

Copies the selected text to the Windows Clipboard, so that you can paste it somewhere else. **Note:** You can also select a portion of the text from the text box in the lower half of the YACC window.

### **Delete Button**

Removes the selected text from the YACC list box.

### **Empty Button**

Empties the YACC list box. This will free up any memory that YACC uses to store your previous text copies and cuts.

### **Quit Button**

You guessed it. Choose this button if you want to close YACC. When you quit YACC any selections that have been saved will be lost.

The essence of "user-supported" software is to provide personal computer users with quality software without high prices, and yet to provide incentive for programmers to continue to develop new products. ## Shareware


Shareware distribution gives users a chance to try software before buying it. If you try a Shareware program and continue using it, you are expected to register. Individual programs differ on details -- some request registration while others require it, some specify a maximum trial period. With registration, you get anything from the simple right to continue using the software to an updated program with printed manual.

Copyright laws apply to both Shareware and commercial software, and the copyright holder retains all rights, with a few specific exceptions as stated below. Shareware authors are accomplished programmers, just like commercial authors, and the programs are of comparable quality. (In both cases, there are good programs and bad ones!) The main difference is in the method of distribution. The author specifically grants the right to copy and distribute the software, either to all and sundry or to a specific group. For example, some authors require written permission before a commercial disk vendor may copy their Shareware.

Shareware is a distribution method, not a type of software. You should find software that suits your needs and pocketbook, whether it's commercial or Shareware. The Shareware system makes fitting your needs easier, because you can try before you buy, and because the overhead is low, prices are low also. Shareware has the ultimate money-back guarantee -- if you don't use the product, you don't pay for it.

## YACC Window

Click on Buttons and other areas of the screen for details about that area.



**Copy Button**

Copies the selected text to the Windows Clipboard, so that you can paste it somewhere else. **Note:** You can also select a portion of the text from the text box in the lower half of the YACC window.

**Delete Button**

Removes the selected text from the YACC list box.

**Empty Button**

Empties the YACC list box. This will free up any memory that YACC uses to store your previous text copies and cuts.

**Quit Button**

You guessed it. Choose this button if you want to close YACC. When you quit YACC any selections that have been saved will be lost.

**Bytes**

Displays the number of bytes (characters) that the currently selected text occupies. This can be handy for counting the number of characters in a selection. Sometimes you might be limited to a certain number of characters for an input field.

**Text Box**

YACC remembers the text that you copy or cut to the Windows Clipboard each time you copy or cut. YACC stores the text in the list box above. YACC displays the text here in a more readable manner. You can use the scrollbar on the right side of this box to scroll up or down to see more of the selected text.

## **List Box**

YACC remembers the text that you copy or cut to the Windows Clipboard each time you copy or cut. YACC stores the text in this list box. When you click on a selection in the list box, YACC displays the text in a more readable manner in the text box in the lower half of its window.

You can **Click** on a selection in the list box in the upper half of the YACC window to see the text more easily in the text box located in the lower half of the window.

You can **Double-Click** on a selection in the list box in the upper half of the YACC window to copy that text to the Windows Clipboard and return to the application that you were using before you switched to YACC. This is the same as the Copy button, but quicker.
