Level of Difficulty

There are three levels of difficulty in **ANIMAL BITS**. They are easy, medium, and hard. The difference in difficulty is determined by the number of puzzle pieces in each puzzle. To change the level of difficulty, press one of the three buttons. When a button is pressed, it turns to green to show that it is the active button. The default level for the puzzle is easy.

The easy button will change the puzzle to the easy level, which contains 9 pieces. if you are playing another puzzle when you press the easy button, the puzzle will start over.

The medium button will change the puzzle to the medium level, which contains 18 pieces. This is the intermediate level. if you are playing another puzzle when you press the easy button, the puzzle will start over.

Peeking

By pressing the peek button you can see the puzzle in its completed form. The peek window has a close button which will close the peek window when you are done peeking.

Changing the puzzle

In order to change the puzzle you are working on, press the change button. A randomly selected puzzle is generated. The pieces are also placed randomly, so that it is rare to see the same puzzle more than once. pressing the change button while you are working on a puzzle will reset your score.

To end the game, press the close button on the puzzle window.

Top Ten List

The top ten list automatically shows up at the end of each puzzle. If your score is less than any of the top ten scores, then you will be able to enter your name into the list of top ten scores. Once you have entered your name, it will appear the next time the list shows. Press the 'Accept / Close' button to close the list

Progress

Progress during a puzzle can be seen in two places other than the puzzle itself. A gauge on the right of the puzzle keeps track, moving up each time a correct tile is placed, and down each time an incorrect tile is placed. There is also a completed tiles value at the bottom. Next to the completed tiles value is the number of tries that you have taken so far.
