Playing the Game

Playing the Game

Your objective in Safebuster is to open the safe in the fastest time possible. If you spend too much time attempting to open the safe, the game will end. To open the safe, you must select the correct combination.

To Start a New Game:

Click the "Start" Button, Press F2 or Select "Start" from the Game Menu.

To Start a Game From Another Level:

Click the "Level" Button, Press F3, or Select "Level" from the Game Menu. Then enter the Level Password.

To Change your Current Numbers:

Click the Scroll Bar or move the Slider located to the left of the number you wish to change.

To Check your Current Numbers:

Click the "Check" Button.

To Pause a Game:

Click the "Pause" Button, Press F4, or Select "Pause" from the Game Menu.

To Resume a Paused Game:

Click the "Resume" Button, Press F4, or Select "Resume" from the Game Menu.

To Restart a Game

Press F5, or Select "Restart" from the Game Menu.

To Toggle the Sound On/Off

Press F6, or Select "Sound" from the Game Menu. A tick against the Sound option represents that the sound is currently turned on. Select "Save Options" from the Game Menu to save your current Sound and Phantom configuration.

To Toggle the Phantom On/Off

Press F7, or Select "Phantom" from the Game Menu. A tick against the Phantom option represents that the Phantom is currently turned on. See above on how to save your current Sound and Phantom configuration.

To View the High Scores

Select "High Scores" from the Game Menu. You can delete the High Scores by selecting "Clear" when the High Scores are displayed.

To Exit the Game

Click the "Exit" Button, Press F8, or select "Exit" from the Game Menu.

Strategy

It is a good idea to adopt a strategy when playing Safebuster.

e.g. Use increments of 2 which will enable you to find the combination 50% faster.

Tip: Do not discount 0 as a number. Part of the combination may well be a zero.

Level Information

There are 8 Levels to play in the Unregistered (Shareware) Version of Safebuster.

The Registered version contains 20 Levels

Each Level is made up of three Stages, and each level has it's own unique Level Password.

At the end of every level there is a Bonus Round, which enables you to increase or decrease your score by up to 300 points.

Bonus Rounds

There are Bonus Rounds at the end of every level of Safebuster. You are able to increase or decrease your score by up to 300 points. Simply select one of the "Bonus" buttons to receive your bonus! A "+" in front of the number indicates an increase in your score, while a "-" indicates a decrease in your score.

You must select a "Bonus" button, there is no way of avoiding the Bonus Round.

Game Menu Commands

Start

Starts a new game. If you are already in a game and would like to restart it, select the menu option "Restart."

Level

Allows you start a game from another level. However, a Level Password is required.

Restart

Enables you to stop your current game and begin a new one.

Pause / Resume

Allows you to Pause your game, or Resume a game you have paused.

Sound

The Sound can be toggled on / off. A tick against this option denotes that the Sound is currently on.

Phantom

The Phantom can be toggled on / off. A tick against this option denotes that the Phantom is currently on.

Save Options

Your current Sound and Phantom configuration will be saved and made default if you select this option.

High Scores

The current High Scores will be shown. You can also clear them by selecting "Clear" when the Game Over / High Score Screen is displayed.

Register

Enables you to register Safebuster.

Exit

Stops your fun and exits the game.
