

Hello from Norman,Ok!

The program `UNPROTBA.JWG' is the key file to "unlock" those "protected" basica programs that some people just can't get around. What you have is a file header byte that tells the program to load and maintain the program in basica's executable form. That is to say, different than your standard: 10 print "Hi".

What you need to do is:

1. Make a copy of your basic file!
2. Load the copy in basica, gw or whatever.
3. DON'T RUN IT YET!
4. Type BLOAD "unprotba.jwg",&h464
5. Save "FILENAME.EXT"

DON'T FORGET THIS PART!

What you have just done is overwritten the header byte that was an FFh (protect), with a 00h (unprotect).
