RULES OF MAXIJONGG

You may already know them. Just remove all of the tiles from the board, by pairs. The only condition to remove a pair is that both tiles must be free (no tiles ON them, and at least one side free -- no tile on the left or no tile on the right). The tiles must be identical, unless they belong to a Flower or a Season family. In this case, they only have to be from the same family. There are four of each kind of tile (i.e. two pairs) on the board and only four season tiles and four flower tiles.

MENU OPTIONS

FILE

Start New game: Starts a new classic Maxi Jongg Solitaire game.

Exit from this game: Exits from the current game.

Load game: Loads a previously saved game.

Save game: Saves the current game.

Exit : Quits Maxi Jongg.

OPTIONS

Layouts : Choose and start a new game layout from those included in MAXI JONGG.

Tiles : Choose from the Classic or Gold tiles included in MAXI JONGG.



Tile Patterns : Select a tile design from the tile sets included in MAXI JONGG.



Music : Activate or de-activate music.

Sounds : Activate or de-activate sounds.

Backgrounds : Load a new background picture from a file.

GAME

Hint : Shows you a possible move by highlighting a pair of tiles. Using this function will add 10 seconds to your total time, so use it sparingly.

Shuffle : Shuffles the current game tiles without affecting the tile positions or their number. It's particularly useful when there are no more possible moves. Indeed, you can find new combinations this way. But please remember that every possible move left will then cost you 10 seconds, so use this function only when you really have no more moves left!

Back: Cancels the last move. It's very useful if you feel that you have ruined the whole game by making a wrong move. Please note that you can undo as many moves as you want; all moves are kept in a history list.

Pause : Pauses the current game. Get back to the game by simply clicking "OK" on the message box.
Note: This menu is enabled only during the game.
