

## Welcome to the Lottery Optimiser

Changes the way you play your lottery lines.

### Overview:-

The Lottery Optimiser is designed to help you finding those elusive lines that generate the most returns on your stake. It is **not designed** to forecast any outcome on future lottery draws, its main task is the pure analysis of past draws, to say it in other words; it is based on facts not fiction.

*The Lottery Optimiser does not want you to stop playing your favoured "Birthday" numbers, because they might just turn up when you stop playing them. However, you should consider to play an additional potential line. Your stake deserves a return, and there are some number combinations that do just that, it is not just luck.*

Of course a good line found does not promise instant results, but it is the continuation of playing these lines is that achieves the result. The Lottery Optimiser based the return result on the stake and the average win of 3 and 4 correct numbers. All others are optional and not considered to achieve the result. However, a bigger win is displayed with a "+" sign to the right of the result. This is only an indicator, because a one off big win does not mean it is a good line (birthday numbers).

### **Important Message:-**

**This program is released as a fully working 30 days trial demo and as such you should not spend a lot of time updating the history files, unless you consider to register.**

## Updating the lottery database.

### Important Message:-

**This program is released as a fully working 30 days trial demo and as such you should not spend a lot of time updating the history files, unless you consider to register.**

### Overview:-

This option allows you to enter previous draws or new lottery draws to the database. The Lottery Optimiser supplies various international lottery databases. Please check for the last update entry and add the missing draws.

This option is **mainly provided** to update your lottery with the latest draw. If you have a big list of draws you should consider to update the database manually using your favoured Text Editor program. If the lottery does not exist click on the "Install Lottery" button found on the General Services Tab and create a new lottery.

### Using Update:-

Select the date of the draw. Then enter the numbers on the "49 Number Pad". The Lottery Optimiser guides you through the whole of the process. When you have entered the draw, click on the "Update" button. After confirming the update you may enter further draws.

## **Optimise freely selected numbers**

Choose any 12 numbers of your choice using the [49 Number Pad](#). This is a quick way to establish manually any number combination you want to have optimised. Once you have selected your numbers click on the "Start" button.

If you are a lottery system player this weeds out the "garbage lines".

## How to use the 6 from 49 Option

### Overview:-

The 6 from 49 permutation consists of 13.983.816 system lines. If you would play them all you would have definitely hit the Jackpot.

This routine was not planned to be implemented and was written for testing purposes only. But it was a very revealing experience, and so here you are, enjoy it - it's an added feature; to use it is up to you.

### What does it do:-

This option finds those lines that hit most, by checking the whole of the 6 from 49 system against the Past Draw Database. Not one 6 from 49 system line is spared.

**However, this takes time!** A lot of time, in average between 72 hours and 10 days, depending on the size of the database and of course the speed of your computer.

But there is a work around for this. Use this option only in your spare time. Once started you **may interrupt** this process at any time, and continue when ever you wish. Lottery Optimiser always starts at the point where it was left off.

You may even set you own starting point, before clicking on "Start", clear the numbers and enter your own sequence.

## Random Line Finder

### Overview:-

The Random Line Finder is an automated analyser which uses all 49 lottery numbers, randomising them in 8 lines containing 6 numbers. One number is always free and will not be taken into account. This option is fast and allows you to quickly analyse randomised data against the database, thus finding promising lines at random.

### How to:-

Click on the "Start" button to initialise the randomiser. It will instantly display the numbers and check these against the database. You will constantly be shown the updated result during this process. Click on the "New Set" button to initialise another random set. A high value shows a good return.

You may choose any to lines to pass to the Line Optimiser. Just click on the lines you wish to use. Beware, that 2 lines that yielded a high return may not produce a better optimisation. and that 2 lines that yielded a medium or low result may produce a very good optimisation. This is based on trial and error. Good Luck.

## How to use Line Optimiser

### Overview:-

The Line Optimiser can only be accessed through the Optimise Tab found in General Services or through the Random Line Finder.

Select either Regular Optimisation or Full Optimisation. The initialisation period may take a few seconds, At the bottom of the screen you will find a message showing an estimate on how much time the task will take.

Click on the "Start" button. You may interrupt the process at any time, just click on the **"Stop"** button. All lines evaluated will be displayed in the Listbox, regardless of the settings discribed below.

However you may print a report at any time during or after the analysis. Select either "All Lines" or ">=33%" or ">=50%" or ">=66%". You may switch at will during the analysis period.

## How to install a lottery history file?

### Important Message:-

**This program is released as a fully working 30 days trial demo and as such you should not spend a lot of time updating the history files, unless you consider to register.**

### To switch to another existing lottery:-

Lottery Optimiser provides a range of lottery history files, which of course need to be updated. When you run the program for the first time it will have loaded the UK National Lottery by default. Check whether your lottery is on the list. If it is, just select the lottery from the listbox. Check that all details are correct and click on the "Import / Create" button. However you will have to re-start the program. You may also change to the required Lottery manually. Open "**fteopt.ini**" and replace the entry to file=**yourNameLottery.opt**. Be sure not to disturb the other entries.

All lotteries provided need updating, so after re-start you will find on right hand side at the bottom of the main screen the information dates the lottery history contains.

### How to import a new lottery file:-

Instead of choosing a lottery from the list, type in the name (such as "yourNameLottery") of the lottery you wish to add to the list. Keep it short, as it will be used for the filename. Enter all other details (ie: stake, bonus, average wins) and click on the Install / Create button. The Lottery Optimiser will create the mainframe for the new lottery. However you will have to re-start the program.

Once the framework of your lottery has been created, you must supply as many previous draws as possible. Lottery Optimiser can store up to about 20 years of a past draw history. When your lottery does also play a midweek draw will reduce it to about 10 years.

You may use the internal Update routine, but a faster way to update the newly created file is; to open the file "yourName.opt" using your favoured Text Editor and enter all past lottery draws manually. You may obtain a history list on-Line from the website of your Lottery Company. Please make sure you FORMAT the data to the requirements of the program. Make sure you save the file as ordinary DOS text, with the extension "yourNameLottery.**OPT**"

The newly created file contains a few dummy entries, which which you can safely delete. However, do not delete these entries without a valid replacement.

**Past Draws**

Lottery optimiser stores a maximum of 1000 draws. Please bear in mind that you may enter up to 50 years, but this will result in everything more than the maximum will be ignored and automatically deleted. The most recent draws should be at the end of the file.

**Format of an entry in the database:-**

[ *Date* ] [**Lottery Numbers**] [Bonus]  
00/00/0000 01 02 03 04 05 06 07

Make sure the last number on the line is the bonus number. The date may either be "mm/dd/yyyy" or "dd/mm/yyyy". **No worries the system date will not be altered**, it is only an internal requirement. If your lottery does not provide a bonus number; omit the bonus number entry. All entries are separated by a "Space character".

## How to use the Single Line Option

### Overview:-

Here you are able to check your lottery numbers against the database. How well are they doing? Did you ever hear about someone, who plays a line that is more successful than yours, well I know about that someone, and I proved the numbers he was playing right. That was the reason to write this program. Finding those lines that are more successful than the once I was playing.

### How to:-

Enter any 6 numbers of your choice using the [49 Number Pad](#) and click on the "Start" button. You will instantly see the updated result during the analysis. Once the analysis has finished you may clear the numbers and enter a new set.

### **Regular Optimisation**

The regular optimisation consists of a specially formulated permutation containing 400 system lines using 12 numbers.

### **Full Optimisation**

The full optimisation ist based upen the full perm 6 from 12, 924 system lines.

**Print Report on** "All Lines" will print all evaluated lines displayed in the Listbox.

**Print Report on  $\geq 33\%$**

The printout includes only those number combinations that return a value greater or equal of 33%. It also prints out those entries marked with '+' sign on the right. This indicates that a bigger win was achieved by this line, irrespectively showing a poor result.

**Print Report on  $\geq 50\%$**

The printout includes only those number combinations that return a value greater or equal of 50%. It also prints out those entries marked with '+' sign on the right. This indicates that a bigger win was achieved by this line, irrespectively showing a poor result.

**Print Report on >=66%**

The printout includes only those number combinations that return a value greater or equal of 66%. It also prints out those entries marked with '+' sign on the right. This indicates that a bigger win was achieved by this line, irrespectively showing a poor result.

### **The Number Pad**

The Number Pad acts as a toggle. Once you have selected the number you can undo a wrongly selected number by clicking on it again.

## General Services Tab

### Overview:-

The General Services Tab is the startup screen and provides access to the main basic features of the program.

### Options:-

Checking an individual line against the database. How well are your numbers doing. Should you consider to change. It is acceptable that one should have a line of preferred numbers, but should you not consider to play a more successful one. The Single Line tab.

Updateting the last lottery database with the latest draws. The Update tab.

To enter and analyse manually 12 numbers against the 6 from 49 Full Permutation or a cut-down but very effective Regular Permutation. Depending on the time you have available. The Optimise tab.

Check the complete lottery database against the 6 from 49 System. **Please do read about this option before your run it.** The 6 from 49 tab.

Providing a button to switch or create a new lottery. The How to install a lottery history file tab.

**Manually** updating can be done using your favoured text editing program. Open "**YourNameLottery.OPT**". Type or use the copy / paste features to enter your draws. Numbers can be entered sorted or unsorted. But please maintain the FORMAT of the database. If you find lines that start with a zero date ie: **00/00/0000** you may delete these safely as they were provided when setting up a new lottery file, to enable Lottery Optimiser to start correctly.
