Introduction

Welcome to THE calendar. We hope you will enjoy it and have as much fun with it as we have had in creating it. THE calendar functions for a year only and then needs to be renewed.

This calendar is not meant to hold notes or memos or appointments. It is a quick display and reference tool. It is for those times when you need to see the date for making decisions about appointments or quickly leaf through the months. The images make it decorative and a bright addition to your desktop.

Clicking on the main display area will toggle the display between the calendar view and the image view. Clicking on any of the 'month' boxes across the top will switch the calendar to that month. The date or day of the month is only highlighted for the current day.

Hot Keys

the hotkey 't' will take you to the month for 'today,

the hotkey 's' will 'size the currently displayed month to the image size

the space bar toggles between the image and calendar views

the left and right cursor keys go to the previous and next months, respectively.

Menu Colours

The dropdown menu allows you to access and change the default colours and text used for the various sections of the calendar. The background, the individual days, the days of the week (Sun-Sat), and the months (Jan-Dec), all can be changed with a couple of mouse clicks to any colour scheme you like. The 'Restore Defaults' is there to permit you to return to the original setup after making a series of changes and you would like to start over again.

Menu Defaults

A very quick way to restore the original size and colours. Particularly handy for those times when you have had some fun resizing and stretching the images all out of proportion. Resizing can also be done quickly with the hot key 's' as mentioned above.
