Here is another Tips system to take look at. In this one Ive added some features I havent seen in others. Here your user has full control over the Tips system. That means user can customize the tips in any way he/she wants to. Tips can be added, removed, hidden etc.

Components in this package:

TBitListBox List box with glyphs before each item.
TTips Tips component itself.

Only one new property Glyph - bitmap to be shown with list boxes items.

Description

You can use the TTips component as standard Tips system. See Options property. But why dont you let your users to modify the list of available tips? Perhaps they has their own notes about your program or something also...

TTips lets user hide, show again, delete, add, the tips. Please not that all these operations are available only in run-time.

String to be shown under the tips. (Usually Did you know...)

OnBtnNextClick property

Occurs when user hits Edit button.

Reads Tips (both sections) from given stream. Returns True if successful.

Writes Tips (from both sections) to given file.

LoadFromFile method

Declaration

function LoadFromFile(FileName: TFileName): Boolean;

Reads Tips (both sections) from given file. Returns True if successful.

SaveToRegistry method

Declaration

procedure SaveToRegistry(FKey: **string**);

Saves tips to registry (Win32) or INI file (Win16). Under Win32 FKey is a registry key to store data to. Under Win16 its INI file name.

LoadFromRegistry method

Applies to TTips

Declaration

function LoadFromRegistry(FKey: string; MustOverride: Boolean): Boolean;
```

Loads tips from the registry (Win32) or INI file (Win16). Under Win32 FKey is a registry key to read data from. Under Win16 its INI file name. If MustOverride is True current tips lists will be cleared no matter FKey exists or not. If False - only if FKey exists. Returns True if successful.

Shareware

The only difference between the unregistered and registered versions is that the registered one has not those hidden tips.... ;-)

There are two registration types: Registering **with** and **without** sources.

Registration **without** sources will cost you \$ US 8. You will receive a copy of Tips *with all the additional components* all via email. You will have the opportunity to receive updated versions for free via email.

Registration **with** sources will cost you \$ US 16. You will receive all the above plus sources.

Tips Editor

Two list boxes here. Above one contains tips to be shown in the main tips form, hidden tips are below. The tool to move items between list boxes is :



Move selected item from Tips to be shown to Tips to be hidden.



Move all items from Tips to be shown to Tips to be hidden.



Move selected item from Tips to be hidden to Tips to be shown .



Move all items from Tips to be hidden to Tips to be shown.



Delete selected item in active list box.

Also your user can add own tips (Add button) and change order of tips (using Drag and Drop).

Installation

For Delphi 1 and Delphi 2

=====

1. All files should be copied to the same place.
2. You need to install in the Delphi Tips.dcu file.

For Delphi 3

=====

1. All files should be copied to the same place.
2. Open in Delphi TipsSystem.dpk package (File -> Open -> in the dialog choose "files of type" - "Delphi package source").
3. Press "Install" speed button.
4. Make sure that folder with Tips System is in your library path:
Tools -> Environment Options -> Library -> Library Path

For C++ Builder

=====

1. All files should be copied to the same place (\$\{BCB}\lib directory)...
2. In the C++ Builder menu: Component -> Install...
3. Install files tips.OBJ
