

Confirm

Overview

Allows you to cause a confirm dialogue box to popup with a custom message that gives the user a choice of Ok or Cancel to the question. The user's choice may either cause them to go to another URL or cause an alert dialogue box to pop up. The Confirm dialogue box occurs when the user clicks on a hyperlink, form button or image. Java Script It! cannot apply this Confirm dialogue box to already existing hyperlinks or form buttons, but can apply it to already existing images. The Confirm application will create its own hyperlink around the text that you select (highlight). Likewise, the Confirm application will create its own form button for the user to click on.

Browser Compatibility

- Works fully in Netscape Navigator 2.01 and higher
- Works fully in Microsoft Internet Explorer 3.0 and higher
- Old browsers may display the button as text because they do not understand form buttons (that is if you choose to make a button)

Troubleshooting

- Selecting (highlighting) text that is already surrounded by a hyperlink (``) may cause errors. If possible, get rid of already existing hyperlink and let Java Script It! apply its own.
- Do not use a quote (the character `"`) in the button caption or any messages because it will cause an error in the browser.
- Do not use an apostrophe (the character `'`) in any messages because it will cause an error in the browser.
