

# Open Window

## Overview

Allows you to create a new browser window with custom settings (can eliminate toolbar etc and specify size) and load the new window with the URL that you specify. The new window will be created and loaded when the user clicks on the hyperlink that Java Script It! creates around the text or image that you specify. You cannot add the Open Window hyperlink to an already existing hyperlink.

## Browser Compatibility

- Works fully in Netscape Navigator 3.0 and higher
- Works in Microsoft Internet Explorer 3.0 but if custom window size is specified, window will not be resizeable regardless of what you specify
- Works fully in Microsoft Internet Explorer 4.0 and higher
- Old browsers will also display a URL not found dialogue box when hyperlink hyperlink is clicked

## Troubleshooting

- Make sure the URL's that will be loaded into the new window is correct. Type it in just like you would in a regular HTML editor. The URL's may be relative ("links/test.htm") or absolute ("http://www.test.com/links/goto.htm").
- Selecting (highlighting) text that is already surrounded by a hyperlink (<a href="..">) may cause errors. If possible, get rid of already existing hyperlink and let Java Script It! apply its own.
- Make sure your document has a head tag (<head>....</head>) or else Java Script It! will not be able to insert the java script code.
- Do not use a quote (the character ") in the caption of the button because it will cause an error in the browser.
