

Steps for Graphic Rollovers

1. Load

Click on the **Load** button to load the HTML file that you wish to add the Graphic Rollovers to. The document that you load will be listed in the Current Document text field. Please note that the Graphic Rollovers are not actually applied to the document until you save it (**Update** or **Save As**).

2. Select Graphics

Select the graphic(s) you want to add a rollover graphic to from the **Graphics found in current document** list. You may select more than one graphic at a time but all the graphics selected will have the same rollover image. Note that each graphic should already have a hyperlink around it or else the rollover will not work.

3. Set Rollover Graphic

Click the **Set Rollover Graphic** button and type in the URL for the rollover graphic. The rollover graphic is the image that will appear (replace loaded graphic) when the user's mouse travels over the graphic(s) selected in the **Graphics found in current document** list. Repeat steps 2 and 3 for each image you want to add a rollover graphic to.

4. Options

If you decide that you want to remove a rollover graphic from a graphic located in the current document, just select the image(s) from the **Graphics found in current document** list and click the **Remove Rollover Graphic**. The corresponding URL's in the **Graphic rollover URL's** list will now be "-----" (means no rollover graphic). Netscape's Navigator 3.xx browsers may not handle graphic rollovers properly when aligned in tables. If you test your browser in Navigator 3.xx and find the rollover images are not aligning up properly just check the **Disable in Netscape 3.xx** checkbox and resave the document.

5. Saving Changes

To apply the Graphic Rollover to the current document, click on the **Update** or **Save As** button to save. The **Update** button acts like a Save button in most Windows applications. It is strongly advised that you test the page in your browser before closing. If you are unhappy with the results just choose **Revert** under the Edit menu and the java script code will be removed and the document will be saved back to its original form. If you are happy with the results you may then **Close** Graphic Rollovers or load another document (repeat steps 1 to 5). Closing will only close Graphic Rollovers not Java Script It!
