

Get Started

The picture that was selected when you started HP Touch-up editor appears on the right of the screen. Tools are available in the toolbox to the left of the picture and additional actions are located in the menus across the top of the screen.

>>> To modify the picture

- 1 Click on the desired tool or select an action from a menu.
- 2 If using a tool that allows you to modify part of the picture, such as the eraser tool, move the cursor over the picture. Click and hold down the mouse button. Move the mouse over the area that you want to erase. Release the mouse button to stop erasing. The tool remains selected until you choose a different tool.
- 3 When finished making changes, click on File. To save the picture under its current name, click on Save. To save the picture under a new name, click on Save As.
- 4 Click on File then Exit to leave the HP Touch-up editor.
