You may update to the **Master Edition** of Expert Backgammon. Shipping and handling is \$2.50 for domestic orders \$3.50 for foreign orders. Documentation is on disk. The following is a partial list of some of the advanced features:

- set up positions and choose the player on roll
- set cube value and position
- ability to manually enter rolls
- print out games in standard backgammon notation.
- match equity table display for tournament play.
- extended cube search
- scan forwards / backwards to review the game in progress
