1.2 Installing

Installing

Make sure you have all the necessary libraries installed.

"Amos.library" (supplied), "Diskfont.library", "Mathtrans.library".

Then move "FLeagues", "FLeagues.List", "FLeagues.Team", "FLres" drawer and the "FLges" drawer to a suitable location on your Hard Drive and double-click the "FLeagues" icon.

1.3 Quitting

Quitting

There is only one way of quitting this program and that is to press CTRL-C on the Main Screen. Other screens have this option disabled.

1.4 FLeagues.List, FLeagues.Team, FLres Drawer & FLges Drawer

FLeagues.List, FLeagues.Team, FLres Drawer & FLges Drawer

The "FLeagues.List" file is used to identify what table(s) you want to load. Each division can contain up to 25 characters. If a table included in your list does not exist in the "FLges" drawer, a new table will be created in the program for you to edit and then save.

If the "FLges" drawer does not exist, when you first save a table you will be asked if you would like this program to make it for you, press "Y/N". If you press "N", the table will not be saved.

The "FLres" drawer stores all of the saved results which can be viewed in "FLeagues" by pressing "F" (See -
Viewing Team Results
).

The "FLeagues.Team" file contains the teams and player names for the Play Game / Random Game options. When adding to this file make sure that the team name starts with a #, ie. #Brighton & Hove Albion, this name must match the team name in "FLeagues" exactly or it will not be accessed. The next line must be the goalkeeper, the next ten lines are the outfield players, it doesn't matter what order you put them in.

1.5 Using

Using

After entering incorrect data, you can usually return to the Main Screen by pressing "ESC". This will not store any changes you have made.

Most of the functions are fairly straight forward, apart from selecting teams. When selecting a team you do not need to type in the whole name;

Select ADD A RESULT ?, then press Y

At the request HOME TEAM >, type C

Then press "Return"

It will now select the highest positioned team beginning with "C". If there is more than one team with the letter "C", press "." (fullstop) to advance to the next one. It will display an empty string when no more teams are available. Pressing "Return" again will select the displayed team. You can include more letters if you prefer to shorten the list.

1.6 Viewing The Table

Viewing The Table

When viewing the table you can also press "P", this will display.

- * Any points removed (points displayed as white if points removed).
- * Total points a team is capable of getting.
- * Position changes of teams when scores have been added.
(after quitting and restarting these will return to unchanged)

To remove, press "P" again.

Pressing "C" will display the points gained in the last six games (if six games have been played), press "C" again for the normal table.

Another feature on this screen is the option to save the screen in IFF format to RAM:(Division Title). You do this by pressing "S".

1.7 Viewing Team Results

"Return" will display more results (if available).

"T" will bring up a team selector to view results against a team.

"F" will return from results against one team to the full list.

"1" will display a chart with the last 74 league positions.

"2" will display a chart with the goals scored in the last 74 games.

"3" will display a chart with the goals against in the last 74 games.

"P" select the page number to view, If there is more than one page.

Press any other key to return to the main menu.

If you save with a mistake in the scoreline or team name, the "FLres/(teamname).res" file will have to be manually altered. Make sure your text editor doesn't strip the end of line codes from this file,

otherwise it will become useless to FLeagues. Each line must end with chr\$(13)+chr\$(10).

1.8 Play Game & Random Game Options

Play Game & Random Game Options

Play Game = Select two teams to play against each other.
Random Game = The computer selects two teams for you

This trys to predict the result of a game, but it's really just a bit of fun. There are three settings for this option.

Pressing "ESC" exits the game and takes you back to the main menu.

Game Speed = Value 1-10 (1 - Not many Goals / 10 - Lots of goals).

Extra Time = If scoreline is level at 90 mins, extra time is played, then
& penalties, if scoreline is still level after the further
Penalties 30 mins.

2nd Leg Game = Allows you to play the game as a 2nd Leg, before starting
the game, you will be asked to enter the 1st Leg scoreline.

1.9 Some Of The Features

Some Of The Features

- * Promotion, Play-Offs, Relegation Play-Offs & Relegation zones can be added. Changing colour when a team cannot be caught or saved.
- * Play a team more than the usual home & away (useful for Scottish).
- * Table sorting with either Goal Difference or Goals Scored.
- * Alter points for a win, draw and defeat.
- * Removing of points from teams that cheat or behave badly.
- * Current Form, League Averages, Best and Worst goal scoring displays.
- * League tables with 2-24 teams, a total of 100 tables.
- * Listing of all team results.
- * Playing games to predict the scoreline.
- * League Position, Goals Scored & Against Charts

1.10 KeyGuide

KeyGuide

Extra keys not mentioned on the Options Screen when viewing an option.

"V" : View Table

"P" : Displays positions changes, total points and points deducted.
Press again to remove.

"C" : Displays current form. Press again to view normal table

"S" : Saves the table to RAM:(Division Title) as an ILBM.
Press any other key to return to view table screen.

Press any other key to return to main screen.

"F" : Team Results

"Return" : For more results.

"T" : Display results against one team.

"F" : Returns from results against one team to the full list.

"1" : Display league position chart.
Pressing a key apart from "2" or "3" returns to results.

"2" : Display goals scored chart.
Pressing a key apart from "1" or "3" returns to results.

"3" : Display goal against chart.
Pressing a key apart from "1" or "2" returns to results.

"P" : enter the page number to view, If there is more than one page.

Press any other key to return to main screen.

"P" : Play Game and "0" : Random Game

"ESC" : Exits the games and returns to main screen.

"ESC" : Exits from most input functions and returns to main screen.
