In the "Demo_Fonts" directory you will find five different directories containing various files. Here is a description of the files that are in each directory and what to do with them.

Please note: We have supplied BOTH bitmap and compugraphic scalable versions of the same fonts. If you wish to install both versions on your system you MUST install the bitmap version first and then install the CG version by clicking on the "InstallFont" icon.

The BitmapFonts directory (NOT included in this archive) -----

This directory contains the bitmap fonts. These fonts are really intended for users of the Scala Multimedia series of programs. The advantage of using bitmap fonts is speed, especially when loading large Scala scripts and creating large point sizes on the pages of your presentation. Since most point sizes have already been created and are available for your use, you will be able to create fast presentations without having to wait around while fonts are being created and/or loaded.

Double click on the icon called "Assign Bitmaps" to assign the 5 demo fonts to your system ready for use.

If you find a font that you would like to install on your system permanently, load up a directory utility, such as Directory Opus, SID or DirWorks, and simply copy the font's directory AND the directory's' .FONT file to your system's font directory.

For example:

If you would like to install a font called "ReallyCool" to your system, copy the "ReallyCool" font directory and the "ReallyCool.font" file from the bitmap font directory on the SafariCD to your Fonts: directory on your hard drive. Once you have done this, be sure to run the Workbench program "Fixfonts" which should be located on your boot partition in the "System" drawer.

The WB-CG directory -----

This directory contains workbench scalable fonts. These fonts are only for use with Workbench 2/3 Amigas with a hard drive installed. For the sake of simplicity we have put each individual font (and its associated files) into their own separate directories. In each directory you will also find an icon called "InstallFont", when you double click on this icon the CG scalable font will be automatically installed into your system for you. Please wait for all disk activity to finish before running an application.

Once the font has been installed you will be able to load your application, open it's font requester and select the font you have just installed. You will be presented with the font in various sizes. If you want to use the font in a size that is not available, for example 110 point, all you need to do is type in the new size in the relevant area of the requester.

Please note:

Before double clicking on the "InstallFont" icon make sure that you have the Workbench program "Fixfonts" in your "System" directory. You should also check that you have enough free space on your system. On average you will need anything up to 200K per font.

The CGFonts directory (NOT included in this archive) -----

This directory contains all the Safari fonts, in Compugraphic format, suitable for use with the Gold Disk programs... Professional Page (all versions) and Pagesetter versions 2 and 3.

The fonts are supplied with .atc files for Pagesetter 2 and Postscript downloadable fonts for Professional Page. This directory also contains the Gold Disk utility "CGUpdate" which must be run after any font installation.

To install a particular font to your system for use with PPage/PSetter you just need to copy three files, from each font, to your default "CGFonts" directory. For example, if you want to install a font called "ReallyCool" for use with PPage/PSetter it's simply a matter co copying the three files...

ReallyCool.dat ReallyCool.lib ReallyCool.metric

to the CGFonts directory. The best (and easiest) way of doing this is to use a directory utility such as Directory Opus, DIRWorks or SID. Once you have done this for all the fonts you want to install, be sure to run CGUpdate.

If you have a postscript printer, you should copy the ReallyCool.psfont to the CGFonts:PS directory.

The Typel directory ------

This directory contains all the fonts in Type 1 format. These are the fonts you will be interested in if you use; Pagestream, FinalCopy2R2, Wordworth3+, FinalWriter, Lightwave, Imagine etc..

The TrueType directory ------

This directory obviously contains the Truetype versions of the Safari fonts. Although Truetype fonts are not used extensively on the Amiga programs such as Wordworth 3+ and Pagestream 3 can use them.
