

Common Problems running **Fun Pack 2 for Windows**:

If you are having difficulties running **Fun Pack 2 for Windows**, check for one of the following possible causes:

Installation

- You installed the program while running the File Manager in Microsoft Windows, or some other shell program (e.g. *NORTON'S DESKTOP*).
- Your files were corrupted during installation. This can happen on the following computers that have a Phoenix BIOS chip: **AT&T, DEC, DELL, GATEWAY** and **ZENITH**.
- You installed the program onto a compressed drive.
- Your files did not install onto your hard drive. On rare occasions, the installation program will go through the entire installation process and report a successful installation and not copy the files to the hard drive. Change to the program directory and type **DIR** to see how many files are in the directory. If no files are found, the program did not install.

Memory

- You do not have enough free resources to run the program. To free up more resources, close any other applications you have running instead of minimizing them. Remove any screen saver or sound programs. Set the Wallpaper to **None**. You will find the setting for this in the Main Program Group, under the Control Panel Icon and selecting the Desktop Icon. Check the **Load=** and **Run=** lines in your **WIN.INI** file. Delete anything after the = signs.
- You are running a conflicting program. Programs that may conflict with **Fun 2 Pack for Windows** include *TALKING ICONS, ICON DO IT, ICON HEAR IT*, and the following screen saver programs: *OPUS, IDELWHILE* and *AFTER DARK*.

Miscellaneous

- The icons are dimmed or nothing comes up after the title screen. On some computer models some of the individual games will lock up if run from the icon. Run the individual games by double-clicking on the game's **.EXE** file in File Manager.

Sound

If you are having difficulty hearing the sound, music or speech, check the following possible causes:

- Your sound card is not installed/configured properly.

- You do not have the **Sound** option turned on.

- You do not have enough resources to run the program and the sound driver at the same time. To free up more resources, close any other applications you have running instead of minimizing them. Remove any screen saver or sound programs. Set the Wallpaper to **None**. You will find the setting for this in the Main Program Group, under the Control Panel Icon and selecting the Desktop Icon. Check the **Load=** and **Run=** lines in your **WIN.INI** file. Delete anything after the = signs.

- The individual game does not have any sound. See the individual game notes to see which games do not have any sound.

Individual Games

Destroyer

The game window can be **Maximized**.

You can only use the mouse to play the game.

Gecko

The game window can not be **Maximized**.
There is no sound for this game.
Help screens are available.
You can use the keyboard or the mouse to play the game.

The game window can be **Maximized**.
There is sound for this game.
Help screens are available (1 screen).
You can only use the keyboard to play the game.

Runner

The game window can be **Maximized**.
There is sound for this game.
Help screens are available.
You can use the keyboard, a joystick or the mouse to play the game.

Runner will not work on a compressed drive.

Stellar

The game window can not be **Maximized**.
There is sound for this game.

Help screens are available (1 screen).
You can only use the keyboard to play the game.

Tail Gunner

The game window can be **Maximized**.
There is sound for this game.
Help screens are available(1 screen).
You can only use the mouse to play the game.

Time Warp

The game window can not be **Maximized**.
There is sound for this game.
Help screens are available.
You can only use the keyboard to play the game.
