How to Play

- When the game starts, <u>choose</u> a player.
 When the main Video Draw Poker screen appears, make a <u>bet</u>.
- 3. If you bet less than the maximum, click on 'Deal' when your ready to play (if you bet the maximum, the game will automatically start the game by dealing).
- 4. Click on the cards that you wish to keep.
- 5. Click on 'Deal' to continue.

For those in a hurry: for the next deal click on the Right Mouse Button while pointing at one of the cards. This will result in the same action as clicking on either "Bet Max" or "Deal" -whichever action is available at that time.

Betting

To bet a single coin click on "Bet One". You may bet additional coins by continuing to click on "Bet One" until you hit the maximum.

To bet the maximum click on "Bet Max". Jackpots are only payed out on the maximum bet.

For those in a hurry: for the next deal click on the Right Mouse Button while pointing at one of the cards. This will result in the same action as clicking on either "Bet Max" or "Deal" -- whichever action is available at that time.

Winning Hands

The amount that a hand pays will vary depending on the payouts set in the <u>preference</u> dialog box. The following tables show the payouts given when using the authors default payouts.

Choose Player

Select Choose Player from the Game menu. Click on your name under the Players list. If your name is not there, click on "Add Player" and type in your name and press Enter. Click "OK" when done.

Once your player information is entered, the program will automatically record your score whenever you exit. Should you run out of credits, choose Player under the Game menu, click OK and you will have the default starting coin (as set in the <u>Preferences...</u> dialog box) to play with.

Card

To change the card deck, choose Card from the Game menu. Click on the desired card file. The preview of the card back is displayed. Click "OK" after choosing the card deck.

Registered users will have a far greater selection of cards.

Preferences...

The Preferences... Dialog box allows you to set your game preferences.

Game:

Jacks or Better -- a straight forward standard Video Draw Poker game requiring a pair of Jacks or better for a win.

Bonus Poker -- Video Poker with extra high pay-offs on four of a kind.

High Fives -- Video Poker with extra high pay-offs on three or four fives.

Sound:

Sound Card: plays the sound of a coin dropping on payouts of over 1000 coins and adds the

capability of comments while playing the game.

PC Speaker: all sounds come over the PC's built in speaker. The Comments option is not

available.

Coins: play a coin drop sound on jackpots and a winning tune on other payoffs.

Alert: alerts of a winning hand if dealt on the first deal.

Comments: plays occasional comments during game play. This option is not available without a

sound card.

Music: plays a tune when the hand is finished if play is not immediatly resumed.

Deal Click: the sound of a card while being dealt.

Starting Coin: the number of coins a player starts with when a new player is added or a current

player runs out of credits. The amount must be between 20 and 400.

Deal Speed: the speed at which cards are dealt during play.

Payouts: the number of coins paid out, on a particular hand, per coin bet on that hand. This

is changable within some preset limits.

Reset Walter's: reset Walter's default payouts.

Reset Casino's: reset Casino default payouts. NB. payouts often vary from one Casino to the next.

This is a good option to choose when practicisng for the real thing.

Jacks or Better - Two of a kind, with a rank of Jacks or higher. I.E. a pair of Jacks, Queens, Kings or Aces.

Two Pairs - Two pairs of cards.

Three of a Kind - Three cards of equal rank.

Straight - Five cards with consecutive ranks. E.G. 5, 6, 7, 8, 9.

Flush - Five cards of the same suit. I.E. all the cards in the hand are either Spades, Clubs, Diamonds OR Hearts.

Full House - Three of a Kind and One Pair.

Four of a Kind - Four cards of the same rank.

Straight Flush - Five cards with consecutive ranks, all of the same suit.

Royal Flush - Ace, King, Queen, Jack, 10, all of the same suit.

Four 5 to Kings - Four cards of the same rank in the range of 5 to Kings.

Four 2 to Fours - Four cards of the same rank in the range of two to Four.

Four Aces - A hand holding four Aces.

Three Fives - A hand holding three Fives.

Four Fives - A hand holding four Fives.
