

*---A macro to LINK a range. Lotus 1-2-3 allows only cells linking, this macro links a whole range, it creates a range of cell linking formulas.

*---Use the /Range Name Label Right {End} {Down} <ENTER> to define the range names in this column (starts with the \Z macro name)

*---Place the cell pointer where you want the linked range

*---Hold the <ALT> key and press <Z> to activate the macro

*---Ranges should be entered as address ONLY! (For example: A1..D5)

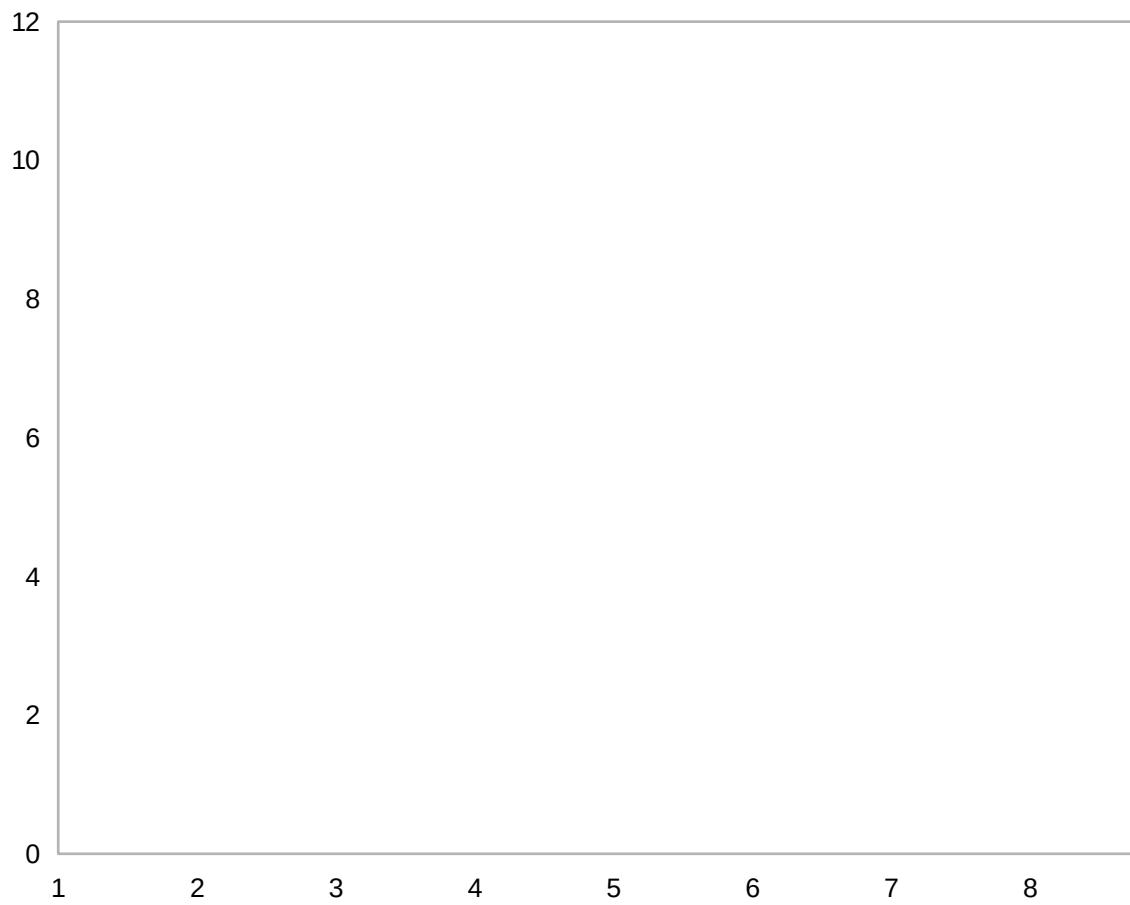
