

- \*---A macro to COMBINE two ranges inside the worksheet. This macro works exactly as file extract and combined together. This macro uses the disk, therefore the disk should not be write protected.
- \*---Use the /Range Name Label Right {End} {Down} <ENTER> to define the range names in this column (starts with the \Z macro name)
- \*---Place the cell pointer on the upper left cell of the range to changed.
- \*---Hold the <ALT> key and press <Z> to activate the macro
