

- *---A macro to insert a ruler for printing measurement. The ruler lines will be ignored when included in the print range. The ruler takes two rows, insert or clean two empty rows for the ruler.
- *---Use the /Range Name Label Right {End} {Down} <ENTER> to define the range names in this column (starts with the \Z macro name)
- *---Place the cell pointer where you want the ruler
- *---Hold the <MACRO> key and press <Z> to activate the macro
