

- *---A macro to set the system time and date
- *---Use the /Range Name Label Right {End} {Down} <ENTER> to define the range names in this column (starts with the \Z macro name)
- *---Hold the <ALT> key and press <Z> to activate the macro
- *---The macro creates a batch file C.BAT to update the date and time
- *---When the DOS prompt appears press <C> and <ENTER> to run C.BAT the macro will automatically EXIT to 1-2-3
