1.1 SwitchBoard is HERE. Let all rejoice

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Hiya folks..

You've just downloaded and dearchived the Amiga's most useful program. Switchboard. Please keep reading to find out more !!!

1.2 Whats with all this crap? Have I wasted my time?

What is it ?

SwitchBoard is a GUI for (currently) 3 emulators... It supports AmigaVGB, the Amiga version of Virtual GameBoy, DarkNESs, the NES emulator, and MasterGear, the Sega Master System & Game Gear emulator. I must admit I forgot that MasterGear now has a GUI built in (Hiya Mark), but after all the work I'd done, I figured it might as well stay.

As you can see by the Version number it's at a very early stage and I intend on updating it quite a bit. I'm actually having quite a bit of fun with this. =)

I have seen both Emullauncher & DarkGUI and honestly only Emullauncher comes close to SwitchBoard. In someways Emullauncher is a little better as it supports a lot more Emulators than SwitchBoard does at the moment, but DarkGUI is for Darkness only and doesn't do much else.

Stay tuned for updates that should eventually kick both those programs and make them (like a Datsun 180b) totally obsolete. =)

1.3 What do I do with the files ?

Installation.

Just copy the main executable to any place you want it. No assigns are needed anymore, but you will need to create a prefs file, which can (and must) now be done within the SwitchBoard program.

The prefs file will be called "swbrd.prefs" and must reside in the same dir as the main executable. This allows you to delete the whole dir easily and not have to chase up odd files all over the place. But why would you want to delete it ?

Your OLD prefs file will continue to work. It is still a standard ASCII file. So don't delete the old file if you still have it !

I will add an installer script some time in the future, basically when I have worked out how to write an installer script. I haven't look at writing one yet. Give me some time, it will come.

1.4 Whadoolneed to get this running ?!

Requirements.

- . Any Amiga with atleast OS2.0 (come on, there aren't any WB1.3 users left are there still ?!)
- . Enough ram to run both Switchboard & the Emulators. (A little over 100K I think for SwitchBoard. Each emu will need more though.)
- . Reqtools.library is also needed. Not too sure about the Version required, but hey if it don't work then this could be the problem, use SnoopDos to find out. (I did not ask for a specific version, so this should not ever cause a problem, but...)
- . ASL.library is also needed. This is new to V0.06.

1.5 How was it tested ?

Tested

This program was tested on the following configurations :

- . A1200/060 16 meg fast. OS/WB3.1 (AGA) It ran fine and never crashed once (honestly). Okay I lie, it has crashed, but I do know why and I've fixed that bug.
- . A1200/020 4 meg fast. OS/WB3.0 (AGA)
- . It also produced NO enforcer hits, unlike some programs (DarkNESs is full
 of 'em MARK!!!)

1.6 So you mean I have to pay ?

1.8 It's not full of shit is it ?

Does it work ?

Okay there are a number of things that do and don't work in this version. Here are the limitations:

- . Essentially there are no limitations, this is the full program, it is not a demo, nor is it crippled in anyway.
- . At the moment only 1 Emulator can be run at a time. I have no real intention of changing this, unless you lot want me to... I can't see the reason as most Emu's use too much processor time to run more than one at a time.... Let me know.
- . Prefs file is read and can now be written out. It does not have a requester for the saving as it is not necessary.
- . Preferences must now be set using the Prefs editor, which is part of the main program.
- . The saved prefs file will be saved to the last used directory. This could mean some problems if it was not the dir that SwitchBoard resides in. This is due to the fact that SwitchBoard looks for the prefs file in the current dir when started. Please set the last dir used to the same one that SwitchBoard resides in & then save your prefs. Looks like I'll have to add a requester to the save routine now.

1.9 Blasted little roaches, they get everywhere nowdays !

Bugs/Undocumented Features :

If you find some bugs then please let me know. Otherwise I can't improve this program to achieve it's maximum potential !

- . If you choose Ram: from the file requester the Ram Disk: comes up and the spaces cause the program not to run ! I have set the default dir to ram: for the time being and I'll see what I can do about fixing this properly.
- . Nothing else to add, yet.... Anyone ?!

1.10 History. So how did I get to this point ?

History

Ah. The Fun bit =)

V0.01 (19/6/97)

Internal only. Not much working. Had the GUI done.

V0.02 (20/6/97)

Internal only.

About requester now works =) Hehehehe, I know working backwards... I'm learning as I go, so doing the 'About' requester allowed me to learn a number of things to progress further.

V0.03 (22/6/97)

Internal only.

After a few days break & breaking a few days I started back into it. My rooms a mess at the moment. I have books everywhere trying to learning this silly coding. Okay whats working now... Oh yeah, heaps.

. File req now works.

. Program now quits.

Launch button now does something (Runs AmigaVGB on my system)
 The cycle gadget still does nothing but cycle. I can't figure out how to read the bloody thing =(

V0.04 (24/6/97)

Internal only.

Coming closer to the external releasing stage. Now all the emulators run from my harddrive. =) I found a work around for reading the cycle gadget (stupid things). Its not perfect, but it does work. I just set a variable and increment it each time the gadget is released, then reset it to 0 when it hits the maximum gadget number. Its a Mickey Mouse (©) way of doing things, but it works... This idea actually came to me as I was going to bed late one night. Amazing how the brain thinks.

. Changed About requesters from EasyRequest() to RTEZRequest(). Now needs OS2.0+

Not much else to add... I managed to get most things working, just a few more left !

V0.05 (25/6/97)

Sent for beta testing. Release Imminent :)

Woohooo. Okay major developments !

. Everything now works ! I figured out the f**king string gadget. The command "gtgetstring" says nothing about requiring brackets ! (ie GTgetstring ()) Ah well, works now. This had me stumped for about a week.

. Almost all the Requesters are uniform, except for AmigaVGB which uses ReqTools requsters for it's file loading. I'm now using ASL....

. Switched from Reqtools requesters to ASL, I prefer ASL as it allows me to set patterns all in the one go... RT I need to use more commands, which means bigger program size....

V0.06 (26/6/97)

Sent for beta testing. Getting CLOSER !!!

- . SwitchBoard now supports prefs files !!! ('Bout bloody time too)
- . Small bug fixed : AmigaVGB would run twice if no cart was chosen the first time round, and then a cart chosen and launched.
- . Nothing else to add yet... Give me time =)

V0.07P (1/7/97)

First Public Release. (including Aminet)

Thought : Bugger it. It can go on my WWW page for the moment !

- . Added the emulators to menu items. Suggested By Simon Pym. I guess it's for those who have dud left mouse buttons ?! This caused me to have to rewrite a large portion of the program... See next item !
- . Cleaned up the code a bit, there are now less If/End If statments and more procedures being called.
- . Reduced the source by slightly less than 1k from previous version. Exe is larger though !
- . Removed the ßeta requester from the public version + some other "junk" in the source.

V0.08B (6/7/97)

Internal only.

- . Okay I've added the Prefs GUI to the main executable.
- . Prefs can now be read from a requester.
- . Prefs can be saved to default "swbrd.prefs". No requester used.

- . All Menu options work, now using same code as GTgadgets (Almost).
- . Cleaned up code to use less If/End If conditions.
- . Removed bug that had been in code for quite some time !
- . This is also the first version that caused a GURU on my machine. I was freeing up windows that I hadn't opened. =)
- . Fixed above mentioned bug. Luckily I save the source before each compile!
- . Each emulator can be set in the prefs GUI, no more making your own prefs file. It is automatically set to the main code too.
- . Removed 3 enforcer hits ! See even Blitz2 code can have enforcer hits. I was setting data to gadgets that did not exist. Not a smart thing to do.
- . Prefs window now opens if there is no preferences set, forcing a person to edit their prefs before continuing !
- . Fixed one or two more bugs. I stuffed the saving of the prefs file in one section. It would save a blank file ! (10/7/97)
- . Removed some redundant code that was left from an old version. (10/7/97)
- . Now ready for Beta test again.....

V0.09B (15/7/97)

Internal Only.

- . Damn found some bugs = (
- . The cycle gadget can get screwy and select the wrong thing, my fault. Fixed now. Just moved a variable to a later stage in program, it then does not get reset when jumping from the prefs GUI !
- . Thanks to Paul Morabito for telling me about the "ram disk:" bug. Damn thing. I've changed the default dir to ram: in the mean time.
- Managed to <I think> fix a problem with Blitz 2 and may have most of troubles sorted out ! Means development time will speed up slightly. Well I believe I was wrong. It still keeps crashing !!!! <Blitz 2, NOT SwitchBoard>
- . Updated the copyright information, it now includes "Cougar Development" which is what I am going to call the name of the team that does the software. This will include the beta testers =) Arent I nice ?
- . Fixed a silly bug that meant if you just set the string gadgets in the prefs GUI and quit that then those settings were NOT copied to the main part of the program...

. Added a check for OS < 2.0 and the prog then puts up a requester and quits. I have not tested this as I could not be bothered setting up a KS1.3 disk and softkicking into 1.3... Anyone ?!

V0.10B (19/7/97)

Internal Only

- . Small bug fixes. Nothing too drastic.
- . Cleaned up some code.
- . Made exiting safer by not letting Blitz handle it all.
- May have problem with Blitz2 sorted out. I believe it's the debug module that causes all the problems. Just don't use it ! Better write non buggy code Huh ?! =) <For those who want to know it has a lot of enforcer hits which I believe are causing the problem>.<Nope I was wrong still crashes :-/ >
- . Launch window now closes when editing prefs.
- . Started work on the Game Genie cheat requester for AmigaVGB. This will be in the next version !
- . Fixed a possible problem with the OS 1.3 checking. Still have not tested it yet. I was calling a wrong Requester routine.
- . Started work on another project called Y.A.P.C. Wait for this one !

V0.10P (24/7/97)

Second Public Release

- . Cleaned up a number of bugs in the Prefs section of the program. I was doing some silly things there, causing all sorts of problems.
- . Rewrote a chunk of the prefs editor code. Damn bugs.
- . Tested enough & now works satisfactorily. Yay !
- . Uploaded to Aminet again.

1.11 Looking into my crystal ball I can see......

Future.....

. Add more emulators to the program. I have seen Emulator Launcher (cant remember the authors name) and it's nice, but it's only a GUI to launch them all from one easy place. Nice idea I suppose, but you cant choose files for some of them and others already have GUI's built in.

. A string gadget/requester for GameGenie cheat codes for AmigaVGB. This I like and will be fairly easy to add, makes it easier to cheat then =)

. Please note: I cannot do anything to the actual emulators, like change screen modes or anything, so don't ask for that !

- . Stop listening to the beta testers =)
- . Add Wzonka-Lad to SwitchBoard. Requested By Ville himself (Hiya Matey).
- . Redesign the GUI to accept more emulators. I can't see people wanting to cycle through 1/2 a dozen different emulators. Should I put a row of Gadgets or radio style buttons ?!
- . Suggestions anyone ?! Let me know what you want added and I'll do my best...
