for Warp. Ranging from primitives to Texture-mapped 3-D, WGT/2 provides a welcome addition to the toolbox of anyone developing or interested in developing entertainment software for OS/2. Mr. Hall will also be presenting to TBOUG, for the first time anywhere, a demo of WGT/2 and its technologies.

Julien Pierre, the developer of Digital Sound & Music Interface for OS/2 (DSMI/2), a sound library aimed at developers of OS2 multimedia education/entertainment applications will demonstrate DSMI/2. Dual Module Player, a freeware program that uses the library will also be shown. This is a new release that runs under PM and will be unveiled specifically for TBOUG.

This is an outstanding opportunity to see and meet two local developers who are working to provide new capabilities and software for OS/2 and take advantage of its capabilities. If you are interested in games, multimedia, sound, education and/or entertainment, don't miss these presentations.
