

Speedometer

This displays the percentage of free memory on your system.

Fuel Gauge

This displays the percentage of disk space that is being used on the C: disk drive.

Free System Resources (FSR)

Windows uses this number rather than actual amount of memory to determine if a program can be loaded and used. If this number gets too small, Windows will not load a program and will issue a warning message.

Enhanced Mode

If you have a computer that is a 386 or greater with more than 2 MB of free memory.

StartUp Group

This group is empty when you first install Windows, but you can place any application in this group that you wish to start automatically every time that Windows is used.

Meters

The "speedometer" (shows percentage of memory free) and the "fuel gauge" (shows percentage of disk space that is being used).

Shareware

A concept of distributing software under the "try before you buy" way of shopping. You are expected after a reasonable amount of time, if you are still using the program, to register it with the company or author that owns its rights. In this case, it would be WrightUtilities.

Dash V0.9 is an unregistered shareware version of WrightUtilities' Dash. A small Windows 3.1 utility that has a speedometer to display the percentage of Ram available, a fuel gauge to display the amount of space being used on the C: drive, and a small window to show the Free System Resources (FSR).

System Requirements

Dash V0.9 has very few limitations when it comes to using it except that it will only work properly when running it in the enhanced mode of Windows 3.1.

To run in enhanced mode, the Windows Manual says that the system needs to have at least 2 MB of free memory.

Also, for best results, a color monitor is suggested.

Using Dash V0.9

This program is very simple to use and there is very little that the "user" needs to do in order to get the full advantages of this program.

One thing that is suggested that you do when setting up this program, is to add Dash to the Windows StartUp group so that the program will be started everytime that Windows is used.

Dash will save its settings in a file, DASH.INI, in the windows directory when the program is terminated. This means that once you set the meters to your preferred color settings and exit the program, these settings will be saved for the next time you run the program. The same goes for the positioning and sizing of the program.

Main Menu

Dash V0.9 Menus

This program has a very simple menu setup in order to keep the program easy to use.

File

Exit - choose this to exit the program

Color

Disk Meter - to change the color of the "fuel gauge" which displays the disk space.

Ram Meter - to change the color of the "speedometer" which displays the percentage of memory available.

Help

Index - brings up this help file.

Help on help - use this for help on how to use the Windows help facility.

About - displays the copyright statement and version of the program.
