The pictures were created on an accelerated Amiga 1500 using Real3D and were boiled down to eight colours using Art Dpt. I then cropped and saved them as brushes out of Dpaint so as to cheat Telecom out of any money spent downloading blank backgrounds.

They work quite nicely as brushes if you load them into a Dpaint hi-res environment. You could import them as lo-res pictures and scroll around them although they start to look really shabby this close up.

As you can imagine they both look a lot better in their original 24 bit 1280x1024 format but my finances wouldn't stand uploading them at 1200 baud and I'm actually very pleased and suprised at how well they've held up considering the loss of resolution and colour depth.
