Haggling on the Amount of Payment

If you feel that the price indicated for Stuart is more than you are willing to pay, by all means tell me why you think that you should be allowed to use Stuart for less money. I have allowed users to become registered for less than the full price if they have a good argument. `I cannot afford it' is not a good argument. If you don't feel that Stuart is worth \$40 (\$25 for students), then you probably don't need it in the first place.

On the other hand, arguments like `I only need Stuart

for a particular program on our VAX' may find a receptive ear. If you do manage to get a reducedprice license to support a certain program or application that you must run, I expect you to **only** use Stuart for that application. If you're using Stuart for all of your emulation-related activities, it sort of goes against the whole concept of a reduced-price license.
