Non-US Payment

The amounts specified on the registration forms are for United States dollars. If you can make payment in US\$, I encourage you to do so, simply because that is the easiest option for myself. Please do **not** send cash through the mail, though - just check or money order.

If you cannot make payment in US\$, my bank has assured me that they can cash checks from most

European countries, Canada, Mexico, and Japan. If you write a check drawn on foreign currency, I ask that you make an effort to consider the exchange rate - if I receive a check for some number of Yen that only translates to 80% of the required amount in US\$, I will in all likelihood be forced to send the check back. I will wait for a couple weeks to see if a more appropriate exchange rate occurs.

Note to Boris Yeltsin: I don't know what I'll do if you decide to register Stuart for your NeXT. I just don't think my bank is going to want to touch a

check drawn on the ruble. Either Mir or Energia would get you a decent size site license, though.
