Stuart Upgrades

As of yet, registered users of Stuart still receive free upgrades. I reserve the right to change this policy in future versions of Stuart. Of course, if at any time you feel that Stuart has acquired enough functionality to warrant sending another payment to me, feel free. Even a small bit of Stuart income translates directly into many hours of Stuart development on my part. Furthermore, should I ever invoke an upgrade fee, voluntary upgraders will be considered in a generous light.

I have been considering an upgrade fee that may start with Stuart3.0. Users would upgrade every two versions for %25 to %50 of their original license cost. For Stuart3.0, this would mean that anyone who registered Stuart prior to November 1991 would be required to pay an upgrade fee. For Stuart2.x users, the fee would not be required until Stuart4.0 comes out.

Comments welcome.

Note: In the Stuart2.3 documentation, I stated that the upgrade to Stuart3.0 would be free to all registered Stuart users. On sober reflection, I realize now that I've been bringing out these really

nice upgrades and only moving Stuart forward by minor revision numbers. Most people would have labelled Stuart2.4 or perhaps even Stuart2.3 as the 3.0 release.
