## **Transfer of License**

Rights to Stuart follow the license, not the licensor. The original license holder loses all rights to Stuart in the event of a license transfer, except those rights pertaining to unregistered users. If an upgrade policy is instituted in the future, the license holder receives the same consideration whether they are the original license holder or not.

The transfer may take any form, so long as the original license holder holds a valid license to start with. Stuart may be transferred as part of the sale of

a machine, as an individual sale, or even given away. You can only sell or give away what copies you have. You may not transfer portions of a site license - you must transfer the entire license.

If a Stuart license changes hands, I would like to know about it. If I am not notified of the change, I may not be able to fully support the new license holder. Any form of notification will do, though email is probably the best. I need to know the name and address of the original license holder, along with a description of the license and the date on which the license was purchased, if available. I reserve the right to verify the transfer with the original license holder.

Your license may not be "split" or "sublet". For instance, if a company fissions into two separate companies, one or the other or neither keeps the license. But not both.
