

The Format Menu

The Format Menu provides commands to change the font used in windows and to change the paper size of printouts. When changes are made to the font, the font for the entire window is modified without regard to the current selection or lack thereof.

- **Font Panel... (Command-t)** brings up a standard NeXTSTEP Font Panel. Since Stuart requires a fixed pitch font such as Ohlfs or Courier in its emulation windows, non-fixed pitch font families are disabled.

- **Bold (Command-b), Italic (Command-i), Larger, Smaller, Heavier, and Lighter** - these standard NeXTSTEP Font menu entries modify the font for the current emulation window.
- **Page Layout...** brings up the standard NeXTSTEP Page Layout Panel.

Note that Stuart scales printed output so that the buffer fits the page horizontally. Thus, it may be useful to change the page layout to Landscape mode using this panel. See **Trouble Shooting/Print Font**.
