The **5250Vision** Diskette

This diskette contains the **5250Vision** 1.2 Release in Multi Architecture Binary format. To install this package, choose **5250Vision.pkg** from your **File Viewer** and double click on it. This will launch the Installer application and open the package. Upon completion of the installation process, **5250Vision** 1.2 MAB will be installed in the folder of your choice.

After you have installed the **5250Vision.pkg**, activate the **5250Vision** application by choosing it (**5250Vision**) from your **File Viewer** and double clicking on its application icon.

5250Vision 1.2 MAB Release Notes.

The following features have been included in **5250Vision** Release 1.2:

1. International Languages Support. Release 1.2 provides support for the following foreign languages:

Belgian

- Brazilian Dutch Finnish French English UK German Italian Norwegian Portuguese Spanish
- 2. Keyboard Mapper. Keyboard mapper allows user to create a custom keyboard layout and save it in Preferences. A user can create any number of keyboard layouts and enable them at any time with a click of the mouse. The fully operational keyboard panel provides a visual indication of the keyboard layout which is currently in effect.
- **3. PC keyboard and ADB Keyboard support.** Fully customizable keyboard templates are provided for PC (for NeXTSTEP 486 support) and ADB keyboards.
- **4. SoftKeys.** Customizable SoftKeys Panel allows user to add frequently used keys to the panel and make them readily available

for him/her to use. The SoftKeys Panel is attached to a key **5250Vision** session window and will switch to another session window as soon as it becomes the key window. Any Special 5250 Keys (F1-F24, Attn, etc.), alphanumeric keys or User Definable Keys can be added to the SoftKeys Panel.

5. Additional User Preferences. In addition to the existing user/session preferences (i.e. session identifiers and terminal types, session colors, window position, window size, auto connect, play a User Key, etc.) a user will be able to:

 \cdot set cursor preferences (block, underline, blink, variable blinking rate)

select SoftKeys operation (i.e attached to key window, detached
resizable)

- do image composition on a non-key session window
- \cdot select a look and feel for a miniaturized session window.
- · add customizable sound to key clicking operation.
- 6. User Keys Title. Titles for User Definable Keys are now propagated into the User Keys menus and provide an immediate feedback to the user.
- 7. Attribute Inspector. 5250Vision Attribute Inspector allows you

to examine various 5250 attributes (including non-displayable attributes) and is a valuable diagnostic and debugging tool for 5250 application development.

8. Performance enhancements and bug fixes. Although the performance of **5250Vision** application is one of the best among 5250 terminal emulators, we regard it a very important issue and we want to improve on it whenever possible. Various performance enhancements have been made to the new release.

In addition to performance improvements, a number of enhancements and suggestions that were made by Conextions customers are available in **5250Vision** Rel. 1.2. For example the **Alternate-cursor arrow** key combination will triple the speed for horizontal and vertical cursor movements.

We welcome your comments, suggestions, ideas and critique. We need your feedback to make 5250Vision a better product for you, and we appreciate that you take time to provide us with your valuable input.
