

Installing and Licensing ScreenCast

1. If you will be licensing ScreenCast with a multi-user network license, log in with the user name `^root^` on the computer you will be designating as the license server (generally the same computer as the application's file server). Otherwise, log in under your own user name.
2. Insert the ScreenCast floppy disk into your computer.
3. In the Workspace, drag the the ScreenCast application from the floppy disk into the directory where it is to be installed. For multi-user licenses we recommend installing it in the `/LocalApps` directory. For single user licenses we recommend placing it in the `Apps` directory within your home directory.
4. Eject the floppy disk and place the disk back in the package for safe keeping.

5. Double click the installed icon to run the application. You will be told that the application is not licensed and will run for 3 minutes in demonstration mode. Click OK.
6. Choose the License command from the Info menu to show the New License panel. Enter your license string and either your name or your company name in the fields provided. Your license string is found on the disk pocket inside the ScreenCast package. Click the License button.
7. If you are entering a multi-user network license, another panel will appear requesting information about where the license server will be running. Respond, then click OK.
8. After a few seconds a License panel will appear

showing your information, signaling that the software is successfully licensed.

9. All of ScreenCast's documentation is on-line and accessed via the Help system. Choose the Help command from the Info menu to display the Help panel.
