

ScreenCast lets users broadcast the display of one NEXTSTEP computer to one or more other computers on the network. Everything that appears on the sender's display—typing, window movements, mouse actions—is simultaneously echoed on the receiving machines. The receivers can also interact with the shared display using their mouse and keyboard. This permits remote control of the sending computer or allows for joint effort on a collaborative project. ScreenCast is also perfect for classroom use where students can easily monitor the instructor's display by watching their individual computer screens

Version 1.03 of ScreenCast runs on both NeXT and Intel hardware.
