Before running CD-ROMANCE on a Macintosh, be sure to open and review the associated READ ME file. It contains somewhat different information than this document.

RECOMMENDED SYSTEM REQUIREMENTS:

80386SX / 33 MHz CPU or better
5 Mb available RAM or more
640 x 480 Super VGA video card set to display 256 colors
8-bit sound card
Windows 3.1
QuickTime for Windows (included on disk)
CD-ROM drive

Performance is greatly enhanced with the addition of more RAM and a double-speed or faster CD-ROM drive. If more memory is needed, you should increase the amount of virtual memory using the Enhanced module in the Control Panel program group.

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS:

Insert CD-ROMANCE disc into your CD-ROM drive.

Make sure the Program Manager is running.

In the Program Manager, select RUN from the FILE Menu.

Type: D:\SETUP (when D is your CD-ROM drive).

Click the OK button.

OR

Double-click on the MAIN program group icon.

Double-click on the FILE MANAGER icon (it looks like a file cabinet).

In the upper left portion of the FILE MANAGER window, click on the icon for Drive D (when D is your CD-ROM drive).

Select the file called SETUP.EXE and double-click on it.

This process will install QuickTime for Windows(tm) and place a CD-ROMANCE program group in your Program Manager window.

Run CD-ROMANCE from the CD-ROM disc only. Do not copy it to your hard drive.

When you are ready to run CD-ROMANCE, double-click on the heart-shaped icon labeled ROMANCE in order to...

OPERATING TIPS:

SELECTION SCREEN

Over and under age values may be entered from the keyboard or by pressing the up and down arrow buttons.

Over and under height values may only be changed by using the arrows.

Hold the arrows down to get the values to change rapidly.

If your response to any of the questions on the ABOUT YOUR MATCH questionnaire is "I don't care about that," then simply leave the question untouched. No answer = Not important.

You may make multiple selections per question on the ABOUT YOUR MATCH questionnaire on the left. Only one selection per question is accepted on the ABOUT YOU questionnaire on the right.

To see how many people you've matched at any given point, press the COUNT button in the upper right corner of the screen. The Match Counter window will then display the number of matches for the criteria you have entered. If the counter goes to zero, you'll have to change some of your answers before proceeding.

The Search Word window, in the lower left portion of the screen, accepts up to three separate words on each of three lines. Only whole words are searched for. Capitalization is ignored. If you enter more than one search word, all people whose profiles contain ANY of the search words will be found.

When searching for a geographic location, use the Search Word window. Type in either the two-letter postal code or the common abbreviation for that place (i.e. NYC, LA, etc.). Leave out any spaces when typing a place name (i.e. neworleans, sanfrancisco, etc.). Remember that many advertisers choose not to divulge their home locales.

CONTACT SHEET

If the PHOTOS button is dimmed, that means the advertiser has not provided us with any still photos and there is no slideshow available.

Use the Up and Down arrows located in the lower right portion of the screen to move from screen to screen.

GUIDED TOUR

If you experience any difficulty in playing the Guided Tour movie all the way through, you should press the STOP MOVIE button and then press it a second time. This will stop the movie and then re-start it at the same spot you left off (after recapturing some memory).

You may run the Guided Tour movie by itself without first running CD-ROMANCE. Run FILE MANAGER in the MAIN program group of the PROGRAM MANAGER. Click on the D drive icon (or whichever icon represents your CD-ROM drive). Locate the file GUIDED.MOV and double-click on it. Press the right arrow along the bottom of the movie window to start the movie.

PROFILE SCREEN

In order to close any of the Info windows, such as the ABOUT ME info window, it is necessary to click inside the boundary of the window.

Use the Next and Prev. arrows located in the lower right portion of the screen to move forward and back within your selection group.
