INFORMING THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE ON MATTERS OF POSSIBLE POLITICAL SIGNIFICANCE GENERATED AT INTERNATIONAL MILITARY PLANNING CONFERENCES

- 1. <u>Purpose</u>. This instruction provides policy for informing the Department of State on matters of possible political significance generated at international military planning conferences.
- 2. <u>Cancellation</u>. CJCS 2510.01, 18 August 1993, "Informing the Department of State on Matters of Possible Political Significance Generated at International Military Planning Conferences," is cancelled.
- 3. <u>Applicability</u>. This instruction applies to the Joint Staff; Services; combatant commands; and agencies that report to, or through, the Chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff.
- 4. <u>Policy</u>. When US military representatives participate in an international military planning conference that generates matters of possible political significance, a summary of the conference will be forwarded through the Chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff to the Secretary of Defense for transmission to the Secretary of State for information.
- 5. <u>Procedures</u>. Offices with issues to report will contact the appropriate office in the Office of the Secretary of Defense.
- 6. Effective Date. This instruction is effective upon receipt.
- 7. <u>Releasability.</u> This instruction is approved for public release; distribution is unlimited. DOD components (to include the combat commands), other Federal agencies, and the public may obtain copies of this instruction/manual/notice through the Internet fron CJCS Directives Home Page--http://www,dtic.mil/doctrine/jel/cjcsd.htm.
