Rules & Play

The JackPot game comprises a four reel fruit machine with capabilities to hold and nudge individual reels.

The display window at top right shows the number of credits you have gained in the game. You start with 20 credits.

Above and below each of the four reels are buttons which become active at random to provide the $\underline{\text{HOLD}}$ and $\underline{\text{NUDGE}}$ facilities.

A PLAY button at bottom right is used to commence the game.


Winnings are displayed in the window below the reels. Winnings are transferred to your credit when you next press Play.





The payouts are based on aligning matching symbols on the centre line of the four reels. Each symbol commands different values.









Using the keyboard

Order Form
Entering Registration Information

Shareware

A marketing/distribution concept which permits the user to try a piece of software before making a purchase. The software may be used for a limited period of time for evaluation.

Use after the evaluation period requires Registration with the Author.

Registration rewards the author for his efforts and encourages further work.

Hold button

The hold buttons below each reel become active at random.

Pressing a hold button prevents that reel from turning when the Play button is pressed for the next turn.

When HOLD is selected the text of the button changes to HELD.

The Cancel button may be used to reset all the hold buttons if they are pressed incorrectly.

Nudge button

The nudge buttons above and below each reel become active at random at the end of each play.

Pressing a nudge button causes the reel to move by one unit up or down. Use the nudge buttons to create a winning combination on the win line.

The number of nudges available are shown in the Nudge Display at the top left.

Play button

Starts the reels of the Fruit Machine running.

Cancel button

Cancels any Hold buttons that have been pressed

Help command

Activates this help system.

About command

Displays copyright information and if the product is not registered a <u>Shareware</u> reminder screen including how to contact the author.

Using the Keyboard

The JackPot game may be played entirely using the keyboard.

The Play button is activated by **<ENTER>** or **<ALT>P**.

Cancel (when active) may be selected by using **<ALT>C**.

When active you may move to the other buttons using the **<TAB>** and **<SHIFT><TAB>** keys. Press the button by depressing the **<SPACEBAR>** key.

Tips

Beware the Cherry symbol on the first and fourth reel. It often gets in the way when nudging to a winning combination.

Try holding high value 'fruit' even if it is not on the win line. A nudge after hold may allow you to use it to your advantage.

To stop the payout from taking forever, click the left mouse button on the payout counter. The payout will immediately jump to its full value. Keyboard users may press any key to achieve the same effect.

Sound command

The sound effects produced by the game may be controlled using this option.

Select this option to toggle sound on and off.

When a check mark is visible next to the Sound option then sound is on.

Only one process may access the sound driver at a time. If the sound driver is already in use then an error message is generated and the Sound option is set to \mathbf{off} .

The state of the sound option is recorded in the **JACKPOT.INI** file.
