

# CONFIGURATION SETTINGS

<b>SYNCHRONIZE VIA MODEM</b>	Check this radio button if you want to synchronize the clock with the NIST via a modem.
<b>SYNCHRONIZE VIA NTP</b>	Check this radio button if you want to synchronize the clock with a computer running an NTP time server.
<b>ADJUST TIME SLOWLY</b>	Check this box if you want Synchronicity to adjust the clock slowly without 'skipping' time. If the box is not checked, Synchronicity will change the time.
<b>MODEM DEVICE</b>	Type the name of the device where your modem is attached. Usually /dev/cu <code>fa</code> , /dev/cu <code>fb</code> , /dev/cu <code>a</code> or /dev/cu <code>b</code> . Select the maximum speed that we can use to communicate to your modem from the pop-up list.
<b>DIAL STRING</b>	Type the modem string you want to send your modem and the number to call here. This string should contain all your necessary modem commands to dial the modem on your system.  The number for the National Institute of Standards and Technologies is: (303) 494-4774
<b>HOST</b>	Type the name of the host offering NTP time services here.
