

Special Controls

TextArt provides three special controls that allow you to set two-dimensional parameters: the Offset controller in the Multiple Options image control panel, the Skew controller in the Skew and Reflect image control panel, and the Shadow controller in the Shadow Options image control panel.

All of these controllers have slightly different appearances, but they work similarly: Each controller consists of a white rectangle with some light gray lines to help you with placement and an indicator (for example, the arrow in the Offset Controller) with a hot point (for example, the tip of the arrow). When you click and release the mouse button anywhere in the white rectangle, the controller's hot point moves to the mouse click location. When you click and drag, a light gray feedback image of the indicator immediately begins to track the mouse and continues to do so until you release the mouse button. If you want to indicate large values, you can drag the mouse cursor outside the controller and release the mouse button.
