Thank you for your interest in partnering with Housatonic Habitat for Humanity to build an affordable home for an area family with limited income.

Housatonic Habitat for Humanity's focus is on making a meaningful difference in the lives of families with limited incomes by promoting financial stability and self-sufficiency through homeownership of affordable homes. By providing decent, affordable, safe housing to qualified limited income families, Habitat contributes to community revitalization by turning sub-standard homes that can transform a street and neighborhood.

Housatonic Habitat for Humanity completed 5 homes in 2014. Organizations sponsor homes by providing a combination of direct funding, in-kind donations of materials and services, and volunteer labor. In some cases, more than one sponsor is needed to fund a home. Sponsors often encourage employees and associates to provide the volunteer construction labor needed to keep home prices within an affordable range. This effort is supplemented by others from the community who annually donate thousands of hours to Habitat projects and programs.
