The Last Lakota code talker Clarence Wolf Guts died last week at 86. When the towers of the World Trade Center fell on Sept. 11, 2001, Clarence Wolf Guts asked his son to call the U.S. Department of Defense to see if the country needed his code talking abilities to find Osama Bin Laden. Wolf, a Native American code talker from World War II, helped defeat Axis forces by transmitting strategic military messages in his native language, which the Japanese and Germans couldn't translate. It was a sad day for our country when this amazing, selfless man passed away.
