The Tamarack Sno-Flyers and the MN DNR will be offering the Snowmobile Safety Training Course for youth and young adults, to anyone the age of 11 and older who wish to obtain a safety certificate. Anyone born after December 31, 1979 must have a snowmobile safety certificate in order to operate a snowmobile in Minnesota.

The course teaches the basics of safe and responsible snowmobiling. It covers operating procedures, machine maintenance, rules and regulations, accident prevention, outdoor survival, environmental awareness, and code of ethics. The course includes both a written test and riding performance test that must be passed.

There will be a parental release form that will need to be sign prior to the class date. You will receive your booklet/packet 2 weeks before the class date. This gives you the chance to study and COMPLETE THE CHAPTER REVIEWS BEFORE THE CLASS!!

Things you will need the day of class:

- 1. Your packet with booklet and completed chapter reviews.
- 2. Dress for the snowmobile driving part of the test. You will need: Jacket and Snow Pants; Hat and gloves; BOOTS AND YOUR OWN HELMET
