Discharge Letter Gen George Washington to Pvt EBENEZER DURAND

The Revolutionary War pension file for Pvt EBENEZER DURAND was photocopied at the NARA (National Archives and Records Administration) building in Seattle, WA on 17 May 2001. It contains the following letter from Gen George Washington to EBENEZER, discharging him from duty in the war and informing him of his eligibility for pension benefits befitting a war invalid. EBENEZER is known to have been discharged on 1 Sep 1782. This and the fact that the letter must predate the congressional act of 23 Apr 1782 bound the date of this letter.

The letter in the NARA file is actually a transcription—a "true copy" or certified copy—of the original. The copy is dated 7 Mar 1798. At that time the original was held at the Comptroller's Office in Hartford CT.

Following the 1798 transcription is a new one, made 18 May 2001.
