Thank you for your interest in **Folder Synchronize!**

Folder Synchronize is a command line application. This installer creates Start Menu shortcuts to the program documentation but there is no shortcut to launch Folder Synchronize.

To use Folder Synchronize you must either:

1. Launch the program from the command line (or a .bat or windows script file) and pass a Folder Synchronize script to the program itself (see below brief example)

OR

2. Optionally allow the installer to establish a file association with .sfs files which will then allow you to launch Folder Synchronize and execute a script by double clicking on a .sfs file in Windows Explorer. .sfs is the name extension we prefer. Alternatively, you can manually create file name association with your preferred script file name extension.

Example Command Line

To run a script named D:\Scripts\myscript.sfs:

```
FoldSync.exe "D:\Scripts\myscript.sfs"
```

or

```
FS64.exe "D:\Scripts\myscript.sfs"
```

In the above, FoldSynch.exe is the 32-bit version and FS64.exe is the 64-bit version.

Please see the program documentation for information about the format of Folder Synchronize scripts and command line syntax.
