1. Release Notes

ATR Deluxe will not update its Font Names list if it is open when you add fonts to ATM Deluxe. The workaround is to close ATR Deluxe, then relaunch it.

The ATR Deluxe Installer installs the following files:

- The Adobe Type Reunion Deluxe application in the Control Panels folder in the System Folder.
- Adobe Type Reunion folder containing the Adobe Type Reunion Names and Adobe Reunion Preferences files in the Preferences folder in the System Folder.

Now WYSIWYG Menus

When a menu contains city names which also happen to be font names, ATR sometimes decide incorrectly that this should be a font menu. For that reason, ATR is turned off for Netscape Navigator and Internet Explorer, all versions. This may also happen with other applications.

ATM Deluxe

If ATR Deluxe is open while importing fonts into ATM Deluxe, the new fonts will not be added to the ATR Deluxe Font Names panel until you quit and reopen ATR Deluxe.

5PM Term

Term does not function properly with ATR Deluxe, and has been permanently added to the Compatibility Tab in ATR Deluxe.

Key Caps

You may receive an out-of-memory message when using Type Reunion with Key Caps and you have over 100 fonts installed.

Multi-Ad Creator™

Type Reunion will draw the Font menu incorrectly when the Custom Menu option is turned on.

Microsoft Word 98

Both ATR Deluxe and Word 98 have disable keys that toggle font menu behavior. Word 98 uses the shift key to toggle WYSIWYG menu behavior. ATR Deluxe uses the shift key to temporarily disable ATR Deluxe and show the System font menu. Due to this conflict, holding down the shift key in Word 98 while clicking on the Font menu will result in displaying the System font menu.

To preserve Word 98's ability to toggle WYSIWYG menu behavior, change the ATR Deluxe disable key to a key other than the shift key. See the "Setting General Options" section in the ATM/ATR Deluxe User Guide for instructions on doing this.

To use ATR Deluxe's WYSIWYG menu feature instead of Word's, enable ATR Deluxe's WYSIWYG feature (see the "Naming and Displaying Fonts in Menus" section of the ATM/ATR Deluxe User Guide) AND disable Word 98's feature. This is found on the Word 98 Tools menu, Preferences, General Tab.

Uncheck the WYSIWYG checkbox and click on the OK button.

Other Applications with Similar Functionality:

While ATR Deluxe is designed to interact smoothly with many applications, you may notice different behavior in your Font menu depending on which application you are using.

Some applications such as Symantec Suitcase or Now WYSIWYG Menus have features which allow you to show fonts in their own typeface. These may conflict with ATR Deluxe's ability to show fonts in their own face, or even to group fonts. You will need to deactivate these features before using ATR Deluxe.

Other applications will only list fonts that were active when the application was started. You will need to quit and restart the application again to see newly-added or newly-activated fonts. This includes fonts you activate in ATM Deluxe after starting ATM Deluxe from ATR Deluxe's Open ATM submenu option.

ATR Deluxe is not compatible with the multiple user support of MacOS 9.
