

Additional User Tips for "Five Millennia of Chinese Art : Images of a Spiritual Journey"

The "Five Millennia of Chinese Art : Images of a Spiritual Journey" installation program will make the following alterations in WIN.INI

[MUSEUM]

VERSION=2.1 -- "Five Millennia of Chinese Art : Images of a Spiritual Journey" edition serial number.
CDDRIVE=D -- The "Five Millennia of Chinese Art : Images of a Spiritual Journey" installation program will automatically check your disk drive
-- and if USECDD=YES, every time "Five Millennia of Chinese Art : Images of a Spiritual Journey" is executed, it will check again to avoid the error of being unable to trace the CD drive because of adding to the hard disk.
USECD=YES -- set to automatically check your disk drive each time "Five Millennia of Chinese Art : Images of a Spiritual Journey" is executed.

When you use "Five Millennia of Chinese Art : Images of a Spiritual Journey" you may encounter the following problems.

1. Unable to execute :

- * Please use MPLAYER in Accessories Group to check whether your PC can play CD music. If not, it means your hardware is not correctly installed. Please contact your supplier to ensure hardware is correctly installed, then execute "Five Millennia of Chinese Art : Images of a Spiritual Journey".
- * . There is a dialog box showing a message
" Disk Access Failure : unable to trace the CD drive"
(1) If you put the wrong CDROM or there is no CDROM in the CD drive, please put the correct one : "Five Millennia of Chinese Art : Images of a Spiritual Journey" into the CD drive.
(2)If you use DOS Double Space, it will cause the error of being unable to trace the CD drive.
Please use Accessories Group NOTEPAD to modify WIN.INI as follows:

Set [MUSEUM] CDDRIVE to the code of your CD drive, and reset USECD=YES to NO.

If for example your disk drive code is E, then modify as follows:

CDDRIVE=E
```

USECD=NO

2. If you can execute "Five Millennia of Chinese Art : Images of a Spiritual Journey" but the screen colour is wrong, please use the Windows setup in the Windows Main Group to set Windows to 32000 colour or 64000 colour.

3. If you can execute "Five Millennia of Chinese Art : Images of a Spiritual Journey" but there is no sound, please use the MPLAYER in the Accessories Group to check whether your PC can play sound files (WAV). If not, it means you have not correctly installed your sound card. Please contact your sound card supplier to ensure your sound card is correctly installed, then execute "Five Millennia of Chinese Art : Images of a Spiritual Journey".

4. If you can execute "Five Millennia of Chinese Art : Images of a Spiritual Journey" normally, but one day you suddenly find you cannot play the CD, please use MPLAYER in the Accessories Group to check whether your PC can play video files (.AVI). If not, it may indicate that when installing another software, the other software's installation program failed to achieve good edition control with the video file playing drive program, resulting in the new drive program installed by "Five Millennia of Chinese Art : Images of a Spiritual Journey" being replaced by the old drive program provided by the other software. Please install "Five Millennia of Chinese Art : Images of a Spiritual Journey" over again and execute.

5. If you can execute "Five Millennia of Chinese Art : Images of a Spiritual Journey" normally, but the overall speed performance is poor, please check whether your PC has 8MB memory and a double speed CD drive. If so, please adjust your Windows execution efficiency as instructed in the Windows user's handbook.

6. If your computer's execution efficiency is poor, it may be due to a program error caused by executing the picture enlargement function in the "Treasures in Close-up" unit. Please check whether your PC has 8MB memory and a double speed CD drive. If so, please adjust your Windows execution efficiency as instructed in the Windows user's handbook.
