Information on installation

This program installs a program of your choosing onto your hard disk and optionally creates a program group and/or program item in Windows' Program Manager.

The following options allow you to vary the nature of the installation:

Install:

You can choose from three different types of installation. Just click one of the three indicated options. You will then see in the adjacent text window a short description of what this option will install.

The third type of installation offers you the most control over what to install. For example, it allows you to specify whether to install sound files, which can be utilized only if you have a sound card installed in your computer.

Destination directory:

Here you'll be presented with a default directory in which to install the selected files. Should you wish to use another directory, click the "Select" button. This will open another window, in which you can both select a disk drive and enter a directory name; in entering this name, please leave out the letter of the disk drive (for example, "winopoly" rather than "c:\winopoly").

Program group:

Please enter here the name of the program group into which the program to be installed should be integrated. This will add an icon for the program to that program group, which can be double-clicked to start the program. To refrain from adding a program icon to a program group, simply delete the contents of the text box.

Note: The program can be integrated into a program group only if you're using Windows' Program Manager as your shell. If you're using another shell, you'll have to add the program to a program group yourself.
